Make-up work for grades 1, 3, 4 and 5

Regular class attendance is essential, but occasionally we need to miss a class for an important family event or another obligation, etc. The procedures outlined here will guide us through what to do in the event of more than one absence.

- Children get a "free pass" for one absence, so if you only miss one class, no need to turn in make-up work.
- Throughout the year, no child should miss more than six classes without turning in any make-up work.
- When a child misses their 2nd class, they are then responsible to complete the make-up work by going through the following steps:

1. Check the [Lesson Schedule](#), this will tell you what lesson you've missed and where to go in the text book to read the material.
2. Visit [Sadlier Religion - We Believe, Project Disciple](#) and print the following documents; the Study Guide for the missed chapter and the Printable Activity for the missed chapter. (If you don't have access to a printer, I'm happy to print out the pages upon request)

3. Complete the Study Guide and Activity and turn them in to the catechist upon return to class after an absence. Following this procedure will remediate the absence.

My hope is this will be less of a hassle because we don't have to worry about mailing chapters home and ripping pages out of the book. Please note that this policy does not apply to 2nd graders. 2nd graders can make up their absences by contacting the DRE to attend another session at a different class time than their normal, or they can attend one of the special 2nd grade make up session held in November and/or April.
